Background

The Position:

The Driver position is located within the Zambia COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health Systems Preparedness Project (ZCERHSP) Project Implementation Unit at the ZNPHI Office, Lusaka. Under the overall supervision of the Project Manager, and direct supervision of the Project Assistant, provide driving, logistical services, and proper and safe handling of the Project's motor vehicles during the transportation of the PIU staff, project stakeholders and goods.

The Driver is part of a team, which provides integrated logistical and operational support within a systems strengthening approach fundamental to the overall ZNPHI and Ministry of Health COVID-19 and Health Systems Preparedness implementation strategy. The Driver works in close collaboration with other Project staff in the course of service delivery to strengthen the capacities of the PIU to maintain the vehicle fleet in good working order through regular assessments and monitoring performance of vehicle service/maintenance/repair providers.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Driver:

- Ensures timely pickup of project staff and visitors as authorised and in strict compliance with road traffic rules and regulations, setting a best example of driving practice;
- Runs errands, ensuring timely delivery and collection of all project correspondence and purchases/goods from various offices/destinations as requested;
- Ensures that all vehicle licensing fitness tests and insurance are valid and renewed timely;
- Performs routine maintenance of the assigned vehicles through timely minor repairs, arrangements for major repairs, timely changes of oil, checking tires, battery, water and brakes checks to ensure that all project vehicles at the PIU are in good mechanical condition at all times;
- Uses traffic and weather reports and navigation applications to map out driving routes ahead of time to determine the most expedient trip to arrive at destinations on schedule;
- Ensures the safety and security of passengers and vehicles through safe driving practices, including but not limited to use of seat belts by all vehicle occupants, locking of doors and windows, driving within speed limits and in accordance with traffic regulations and driving defensively and courteously.
- Accurately maintains daily vehicle logs of trips, mileage, fuel consumption, oil changes, greasing, part replacements, etc.
- Schedules vehicle service due dates for each vehicle, recommending repairs/part replacements required; and conducts thorough verification of job done by service provider and reporting any issues;.
- In case of technical defect or traffic accident, urgent follow measures stipulated in the implementation manual and report appropriately, including submission and follow-up on insurance claims;
- Perform other duties, as assigned by Management.
